The **Havana Express** allows you to connect directly with other transit services in the region, including:



The Gadsden Connector provides weekday service between Havana, Quincy, Gretna, Greensboro, and Chattahoochee. It connects with the **Havana Express** at Havana City Hall (Stop #1).



Havana Express riders can connect to StarMetro's Forest and Big Bend routes at Lake Jackson Town Center (Stop # 5). Please remember that your Havana Express fare does not include transfers to StarMetro. StarMetro's regular cash fare is \$1.25. Discounted fares are available for students, senior citizens, and persons with disabilities.



Although the Havana Express does not directly connect with the Gadsden Express & Quincy Shuttle, you can make connections with those services by chaining your trips.

Whether you're commuting to work, to school or for leisure, the **Havana Express** is a cheaper and greener way to travel.

The Havana Express is a deviated* fixed-route public transportation service that provides inexpensive weekday service between Havana and Tallahassee. The service operates Monday through Friday for only \$1/trip.

Havana Express Fares
 Weekday One-Way = \$1
 20-ride Pass = \$18
 40-ride Pass = \$35

Multiride passes must be purchased at the Big Bend Transit office at 324 W. Crawford Street in Quincy.

PLANNING YOUR TRIP

On the map, locate the stop nearest your pick-up location. Then, find the stop # on the timetable. Times may vary slightly due to traffic conditions; please be patient. You can also download the RideBBT app for real-time service information. **The Havana Express connects with the Gadsden Connector at Stop #1 and StarMetro at Stop #5.**

Please note that there are two breaks in service during the day. One is from 8:30 am to 11:30 am and the other is from 1:30pm to 4:00 pm.

**3/4 mile deviations are allowable along the route, but you must contact Big Bend Transit at least 24 hours in advance to schedule a pick-up or drop-off at a non-designated location.*
